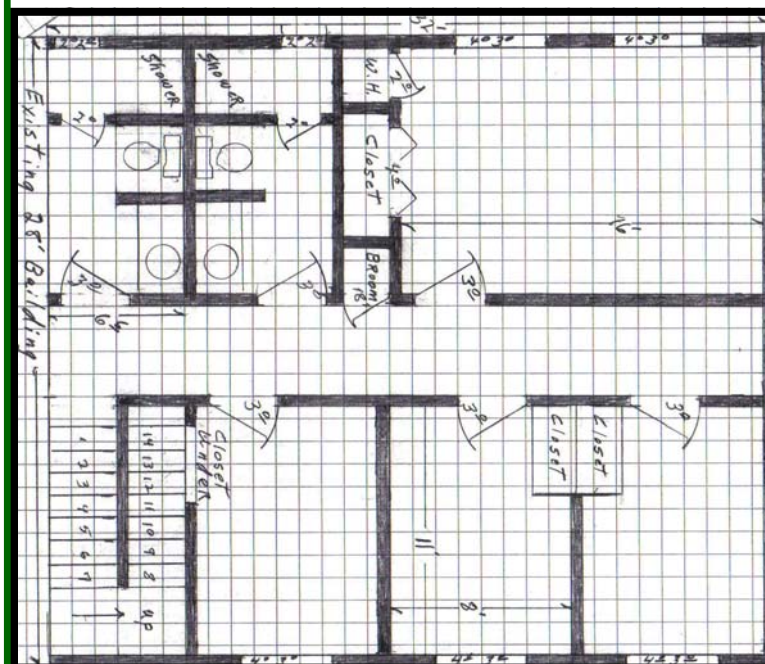
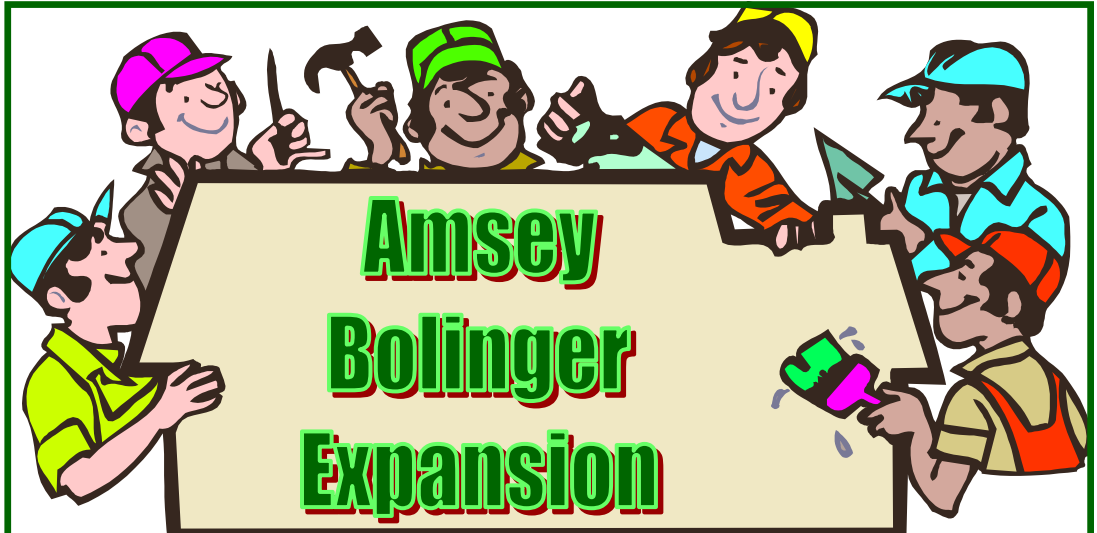

Goats are coming to Camp to help us clean up the back property!

Goats work with the environment not against it. In addition to their incredible mulching abilities, they fertilize as they eat. Additionally, their hooves aerate the soil as they "work." Unlike equipment or sprays, goat grazing is an ecologically beneficial way to clear unwanted weeds or brush and help to promote the growth of native grasses. After the goats are gone, they do not leave behind synthetic chemicals that run into rivers, streams, or into the drinking water. Goats are browsers. They love to eat forbs (weeds), brush and bushes. Thorns and plants that most animals won't eat, are a delicacy for goats. Goats will choose the forbs or brush 85% of the time compared to 13% for grasses. This is beneficial for ranchers looking to maintain the grasses and clovers for their livestock. The other difference is the way a goat's stomach works. Unlike cattle and sheep, a goat's stomach doesn't pass viable seeds. Goats eat from the top down, so the seeds are not spread around and left to germinate. They don't just clear a field, they clear the bad seed as well! More @ www.werentgoats.com



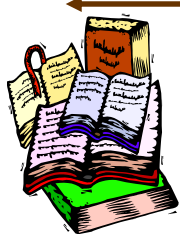
Include Camp this summer
